Gypsy Journey

P3M007) Gypsy jazz is a musical dialect unique to Europe. It has developed, sprouting all kinds of exotic shoots, but has never become divorced from the idiom introduced by Django Reinhardt in the 1930s. Britain's Martin Taylor, a guitar virtuoso if ever there was one, teams up with three Germans – the remarkable young pianist Jermaine Landsberger, himself of Romany background, bassist Davide Petrocca and drummer Scotty Gottwald. The music is beguiling. Taylor, with his almost superhuman fluency, weaves scraps of melody into endlessly varied patterns, which Landsberger tosses around delightedly. Over it all there hovers that minor-key plaintiveness that is the distinguishing feature of this music.
